Re: Tip Reporting App



The Door County Sheriff's Office in collaboration with Door County public schools, is excited to announce the launching of a countywide anonymous tip reporting smart device application that is powered by the **'See it, Say it, Send it'** app technology. The app will go live on Friday November 15th, 2019.

The app is being implemented at all Door County public schools and is available to students, school staff, parents and the public for free. The app can be downloaded to your mobile device through the Android and iOS platforms. Tips can also be submitted through their website.

The app also allows for two-way, real-time communication with the reporting individual (anonymously or self-identified). Submitted tips are funneled directly to the Sheriff's Office, screened and evaluated by a law enforcement officer in real-time. Law Enforcement related tips will be handled by law enforcement officers. Tips that are non-law enforcement related will be forwarded to school administration for review.

The issue of school safety is a shared responsibility. We looked at ways to engage students and get them involved in helping make our schools a safer place and this app does just that. While the initiative is geared toward students, we believe a collateral effect will be increased reporting by school staff, parents and community members as well.

The app allows for a more proactive and preventive mechanism that gives students the ability to report suspicious behavior, problematic behavior, and unsafe activities both inside and outside of the school environment. If your child has any questions regarding the app they may contact their School Resource Officer.
